- 6:30 PM Call-time at Johansen for home football game. **In full uniform, will do halftime performance!**
*After halftime, front ensemble break down equipment for loading after game **(You MUST return to the stands and stay till the end of the game!)**
- 10:30 PM Approximate end of game; tubas, percussion and guard load equipment, **meet at Beyer to unload**

Saturday, November 5 **times subject to change**

- 8:00 AM Rehearsal at Beyer, **LOAD UNIFORMS on trailer prior to start of rehearsal!!!**
- 12:30 PM Rehearsal Ends/Load Equipment (Faster we load, the longer break you will have), **Lunch on your own**
- 2:00 PM Arrive at Beyer/Load Buses Immediately/Section Leaders begin calling members that are late!
- 2:30 PM Depart Beyer for Buchanan HS (Veteran’s Memorial Stadium)
- 4:30 PM Arrive at Clovis High School/**Light snack**/Change into Uniform/Unload Equip.
- 5:15 PM Warm-up
- 5:45 PM Front Ensemble moves to gate (time varies depending on distance from gate) Gate time = 6:14
- 6:35 PM Winds/Battery/Guard head to gate
- 6:49 PM** **Performance Time!!! The Patriots paint Clovis Red!**
- 7:05 PM Wrap-Up just outside stadium
- 7:10 PM Head back to trailers/buses to load and change into “Beyer attayer”/**Dinner courtesy of BBB**
- 7:50 PM Head to stadium (in two lines) to watch rest of show and retreat, **SIT TOGETHER AS ONE GROUP!**
(Chaperones are in charge while in the stands)
- 9:00 PM **Awards**
- 9:20 PM Return to Warm-Up Area/Load buses
- 10:00 PM Depart for Beyer
- 12:00 AM Arrive at Beyer, unload equipment/uniforms: **Make sure uniform goes home!!! ALL PERCUSSION, TUBAS, & GUARD HELPS UNLOAD, NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!! Saxes and Trumpets have bus clean-up!** *(Attendance for percussion, tubas, guard, saxes, and trumpets will be taken after unloading & clean-up)*
